Make Faire is an absolutely fantastic event, in which crafters, coders, makers, and inventors from all around the world gather together for a weekend of creative fun.

The best part is that it's completely hands-on, and invites visitors to take part in everything from 3D printing, to games, to robots, to cocktail making!

By the end of the morning, you will have completed a self-contained project and will leave with a finished piece.
